Equal opportunities should not be a question of financial means. As such, EBS University is constantly striving to evolve its financial aid and student financing options in the pursuit of facilitating access to its programs to talents globally and equitably.

EBS Scholarships combine merit- and need-based criteria and can range from 10% to 40% of the applicable tuition fees. Candidates can apply to one scholarship only. It is therefore recommended that interested candidates explore the best potential scholarship together with the EBS Recruitment Team.

EBS Scholarship decisions are taken on a rolling basis; applicants will typically be notified of their scholarship outcome within 1 to 2 weeks of receiving their admissions offer via email. Please note that scholarship decisions are final; however, in rare cases a reconsideration may be considered if someone's financial situation has changed drastically from the time the scholarship application was submitted.

**EBS Family Discount of 10 %**

The family reduction is granted for the period in which family members are studying at EBS Universität simultaneously within the standard period of study of the respective full-time or part-time programme and pay tuition fees in full.

**EBS Loyalty Bonus of 15%**

**EBS Alumni Award**

The alumni discount provides a reduction of the semester fees of 1,000 euro per semester. The fee reduction is offered to children (i.e. biological children as well as stepchildren and adopted children) of graduates of EBS Universität and is valid for the duration of the standard period of study of the respective full-time or part-time programme with proper enrolment.

## **EBS Financial Aid Guidelines**

(1) An EBS financial aid award serves to financially support university-related education and training. The granting of a financial aid award is intended to give selected interested parties the opportunity to study at EBS. As a rule, a financial aid award must be applied for prior to commencing studies. If a financial aid award is granted, it includes a percentage waiver of the tuition fees as defined in the respective valid study regulations for the duration of enrolment at EBS, but at most until the end of the standard period of study of the respective degree programme. Payment in the form of money is excluded.

(2) There is no legal entitlement to the granting of a financial aid award.

(3) The departmental body responsible for awarding a financial aid award examines the complete application for a financial aid award submitted by applicants and makes its decision on the basis of the multi-eyes principle.

(4) Only one fee discount/scholarship can be granted at a time. A combination of two or more fee reductions is excluded.

(5) The student who is granted a fee reduction/scholarship is subject to the duty of cooperation and immediate notification of all circumstances relevant to the granting of the fee reduction/scholarship.

(6) In the event of discontinuation of studies, the funding received must be refunded to EBS. If the student terminates the study contract without good cause, or if the University terminates the study contract for good cause, the financial aid award granted up to the time of the exmatriculation based on this shall be due for repayment at this time. Should this mean undue hardship for the student for personal or financial reasons, the university will, at its reasonable discretion, determine a repayment plan for the financial aid award granted. This plan shall take into account the personal and financial capacity of the student as well as the reasons leading to exmatriculation, in particular also according to whose sphere they originate, and shall in particular include a partial waiver for cases of personal hardship or an instalment payment corresponding to the completed duration of studies.

(7) A financial aid award will continue to be granted in the event of pregnancy and birth analogous to the protection periods of the Maternity Protection Act.

(8) In the case of a leave of absence, the decision on a financial aid award remains in force, but the granting is suspended for the period of the leave of absence.

(9) The granting of a financial aid award may be revoked in whole or in part, even retroactively, if it was based on false facts or inaccurate information.



(10) The granting of financial aid award is revoked at the end of the month in which the student discontinues or interrupts his/her studies, leaves EBS or changes the degree programme, or the eligibility requirements cease to apply for any other reason.

(11) If a student has received benefits without legal grounds, EBS is entitled to repayment. The repayment claim exists regardless of whether the funding amount has already been used or consumed in full or in part.

(12) The applicant agrees to the collection, storage and processing of the required personal data for the purpose of selection as well as the administration of the respective financial aid award. This may include data on the degree sought, previous education, subject of study, number of semesters, funding already received, receipt of benefits under the BAföG, as well as data that is absolutely necessary for assessing suitability within the framework of the selection decision.

(13) In all other respects, the statutory data protection provisions apply.
